



## ASSISTANT SWIM COACH

**Job Description:** Responsible for assisting with all of the functions of the summer swim team, public relations, and overall operation of the Settlers Landing Sharks. Position runs from mid May to end of July. Work schedules will vary between daily early morning practice, and six evening swim meets throughout the season. Assistant swim coach will report directly to the Head Swim coach. Duties include but are not limited to assisting in the development of seasonal goals, workouts, and helping with set-up and clean-up of meets.

**Minimum Requirements:** At least 17 years old, candidates must have: competitive swimming experience; strong communications and organizational skills; interest and ability to work with children and have the ability to work with swimmers of all levels. Candidates should have the following certificates by start of job: American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, Lifeguard training, CPR, and First Aid.
